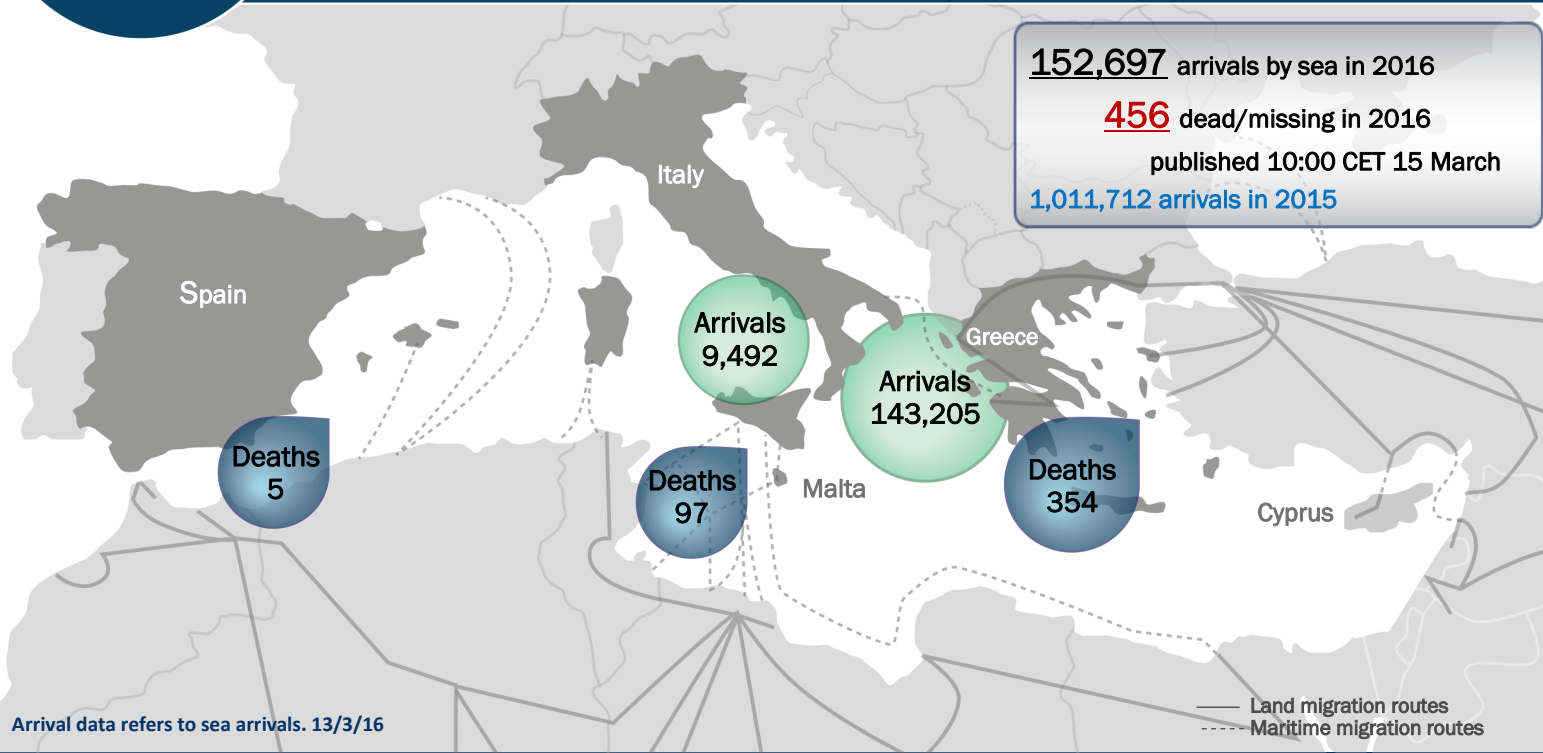

Migration Flows Europe: Arrivals and Fatalities

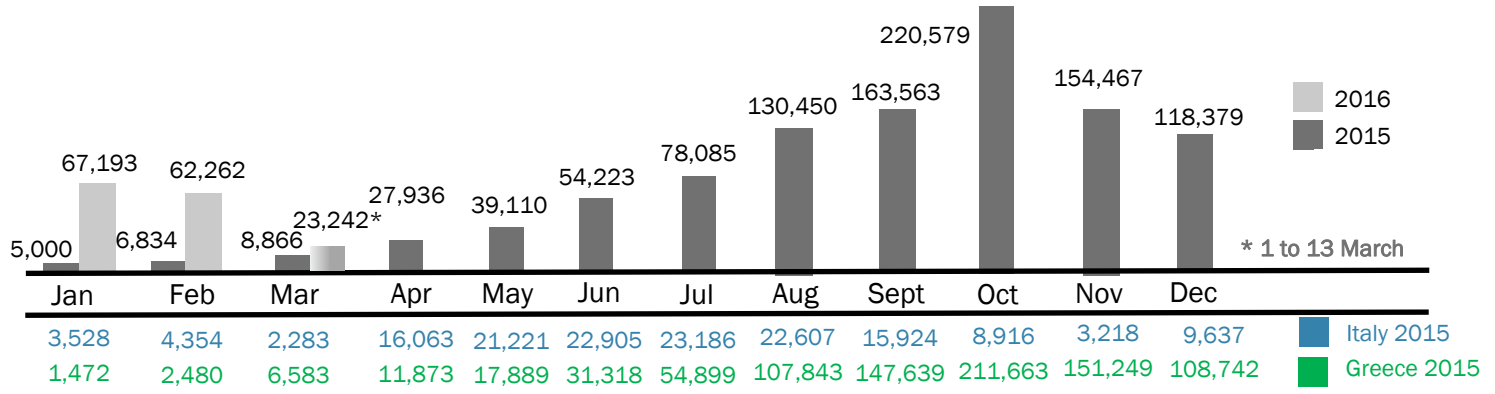
152,697 arrivals by sea in 2016

 1,011,712 arrivals in 2015



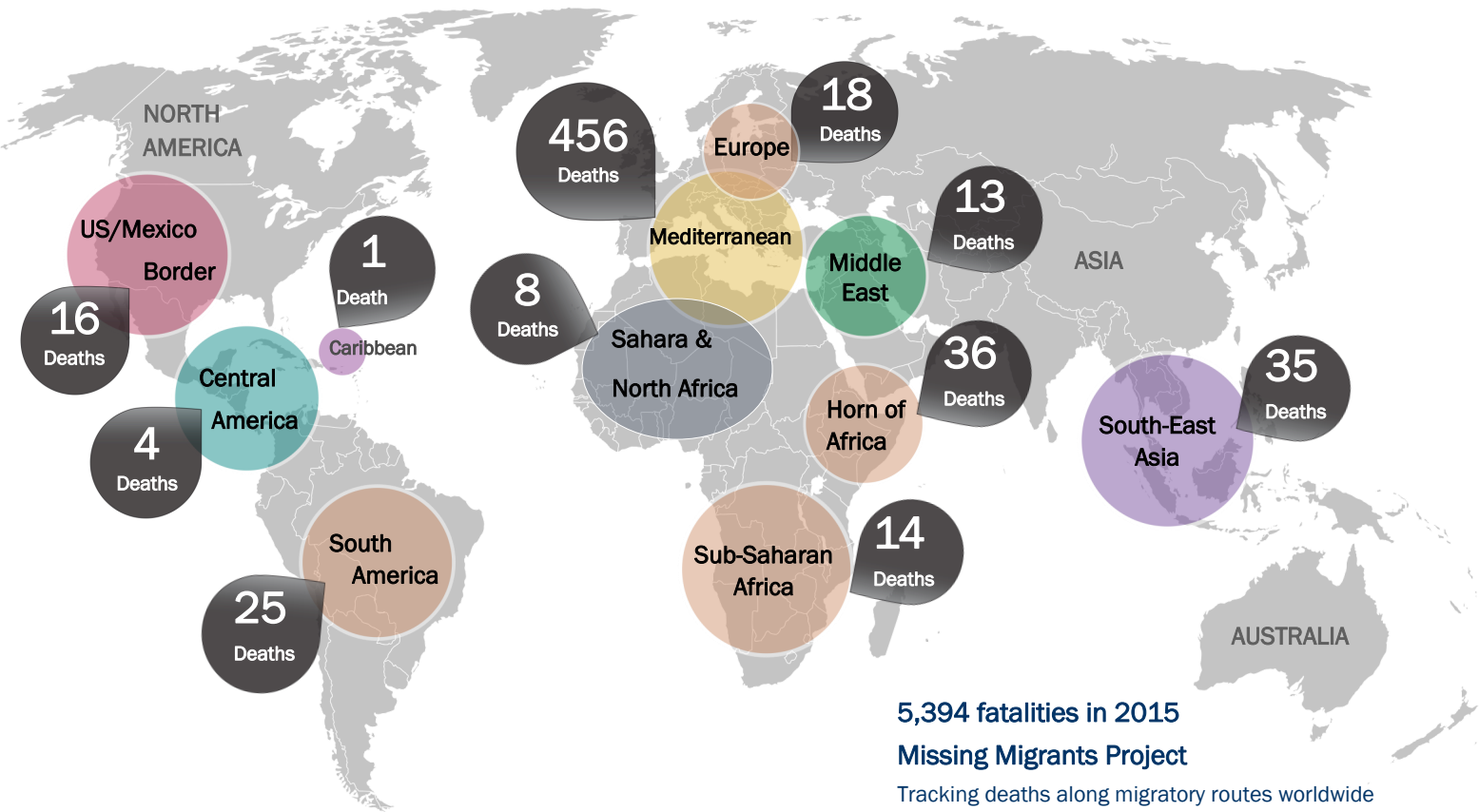
Arrival points through Europe (6 to 13 March 2016)



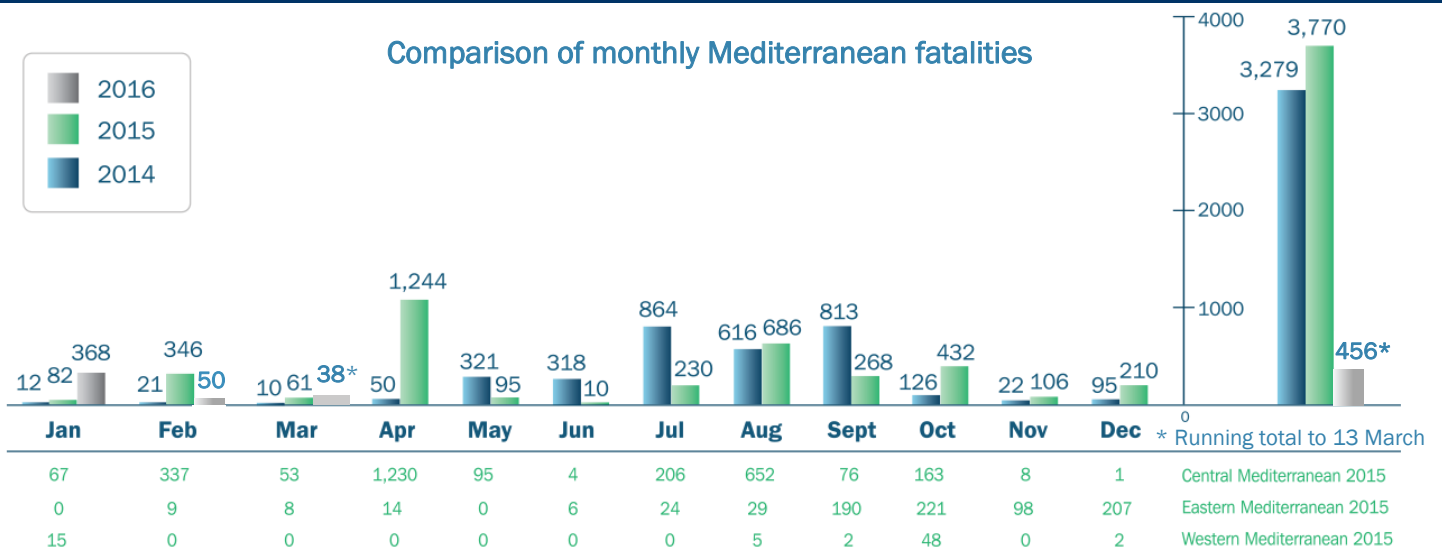
Comparison of monthly Mediterranean sea arrivals
